TRANSPORTATION



Transportation in Marseille

- **Subway train** (“Métro” in French) (www.rtm.fr). Single ticket : €1,5 , or 10-travel card : €12,50
- **Bikes** (www.levelo-mpm.fr). Bikes can be rent for a short duration. There are many bikes station located in Marseille. Subscription for 7 days cost 1€ and gives a free access to bikes for 30 minutes.
- **Taxi** : Taxi Radio Marseille – Tél. : 0033 (0)4 91 02 20 20

- **Airport Shuttle** (www.navettemarseilleaeroport.com)
From the airport to Marseille Train Station, every 20 minutes from 4:30 AM to 11:30 PM. Price for a single way: 8.50 €

Access to the hostel

1. Reaching the "Périer" subway station:

- The hostel is located in the city-centre of Marseille near the subway station "Périer" (located on Line 2, red color – see the A marker on the map below).
- From the airport: Take the shuttle from the airport to the "Saint-Charles" train station (Line 1 & 2), and then take the subway on line 2 to "Périer" (direction "Sainte-Marguerite")
- From Saint-Charles Train Station: same as above from Saint-Charles train station

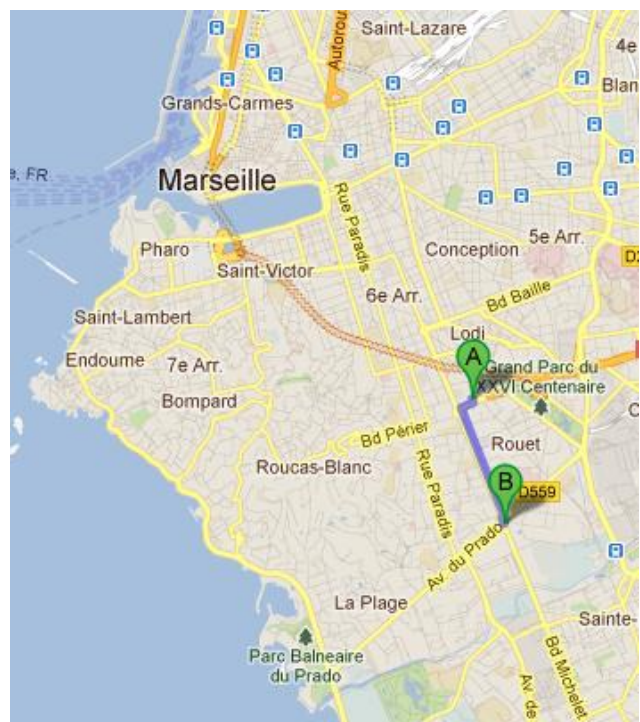
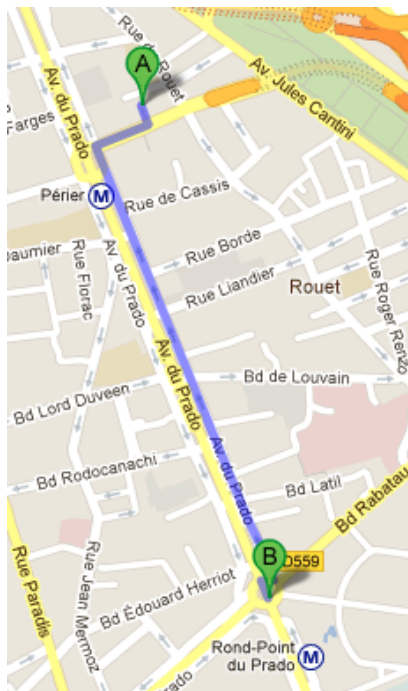
2. From the "Périer" subway station:

- On arrival at "Périer", take the "Avenue du Prado" over the traffic circle. The first street on your right is the right one: "Allée Turcat Méry". Walk until the Residhotel Le Grand Prado.

From the Hostel to the World Water Forum

The 6th World Water Forum will take place in the **Parc Chanot at Rond Point du Prado** (B marker on the map below).

- By walk: about 15minutes
- By subway train: line 2 in direction of « Sainte Marguerite Dromel » from the station « Périer » to the station « Rond point du Prado » (only one stop away)
- By Bike: there are bikes stations next to the hotel and next to the World Water Forum

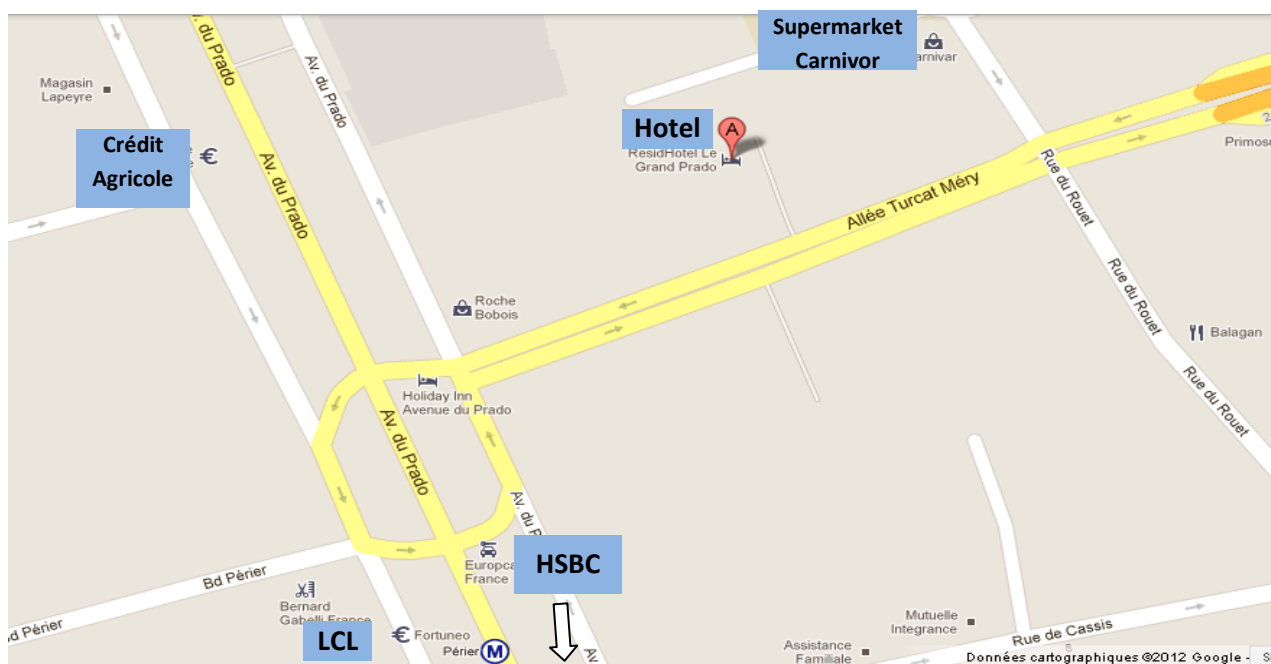


Cash withdrawal / ATMs

Grocery stores

- Supermarket Carnivor Le Rouet :
90 rue du Rouet
From Monday to Thursday: 9-12 am and 2.30-7.3 pm
Friday and Saturday : 9am-7.30pm
- Prado's Market (Fruits, vegetables, meat, fish) : outside on the « avenue du Prado ».
From Monday to Friday, until 1:00 PM.



Chapter 2: Community life rules: how to take care of yourself and of your entourage

IN YOUR ROOM

- Please, TIDY your belongings
- Don't be too noisy (and bring your earplugs!)
- Clean up after using in the bathroom and the kitchen
- Respect your roommate(s)
- You are responsible for your stuff, watch the door lockers!
- In France, people DO smoke a lot but it is STRICTLY FORBIDDEN within the hotel, **so no smoking in your room!**
- And last but not least, please don't waste water!

IN SHARED AREAS

- Please, mind the noise after **10:00 PM**.
- Don't "squat" the corridors or any part of the hostel which is not your room or the "After" room
- Please be nice to the hotel staff and other residents.

IN THE "AFTER" ROOM (located at the 1st floor of the hostel)

- Please, no excessive drinking or noise in the "After room" (or in the hostel)
- **Watch your belongings!*** In a general manner this advice goes for the whole duration of your journey in Marseille, whether you are at the hostel, at the Forum, or in the streets of Marseille. It is very easy for things to get lost...or stolen, especially in the subway! No need for paranoia though, just to be careful!
- The "After" room, is a place where free speech is encouraged: please keep the atmosphere friendly and be sure to respect others' opinions!
- And for the smokers, a wonderful terrace is at your disposal but **smoking is not allowed within the rooms or in the hostel.**

Discover Marseille and the Marseillais with your team, and let us know how they see you, how you see them, and how much they care about water and the Forum. Your mission: bring back photos, or short movies, or any kind of reporting on your encounters....

Thursday, 8:30 PM “Water you acting for”, After Theatre

The theatre company “Water you acting for” just finished a *world tour* with a focus on the access to water and sanitation. **Playing improvisations**, they are going to discuss daily funny situations that are happening around the world toward those questions.

Friday, 8:30 PM It is the last, the one, THE day to party! “Ouh la la!!”

And don’t forget, a video camera will be at your disposal to record your impressions, comments or love messages to the Forum: on the Slum’s area, at the YP’s hostel, or just randomly hanging around, please feel free to express yourself!

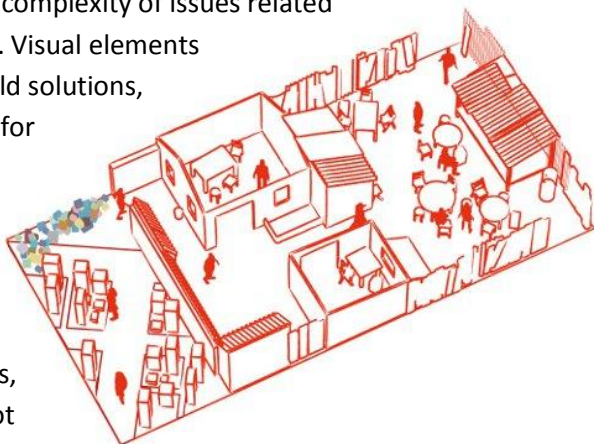
WHERE TO FIND PROJECTION NETWORK DURING THE 6TH WORLD WATER FORUM?

SLUM Pavilion

On the **Forum Square**, the Village of Solutions brings to light all types of possible solutions for water within different pavilions.

The SLUM pavilion will welcome the exhibition “From planet of slums to planet of solutions” with a focus on solutions for access to water and sanitation in slums. Organized around a reproduction of informal settlements, the exhibition space presents the diversity of slums’ realities around the world and the complexity of issues related to access to basic services. 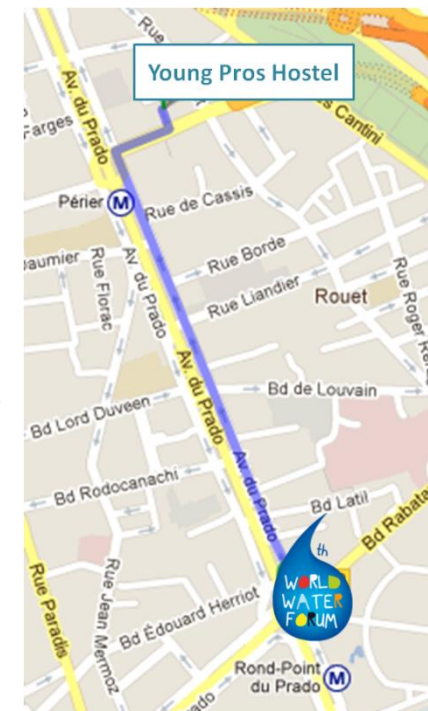
The Afters’ Room is located at the 1st floor of the Young Pros hostel.
